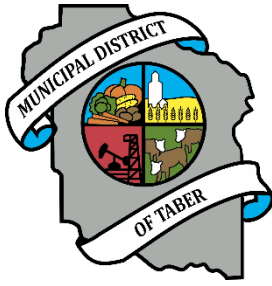
Parade goes Rain or Shine!

Line up starts at 2:30pm at 50 ave and 47 st Facing East. The LDS parking lot can be used for staging before/after but vehicles and garbage must be removed immediately after the parade. Please enter Taber at Highway 864 and proceed north to 50 ave. The line up will be on this street facing east. (This is especially important for large machinery so you are in the proper lane for lineup. If you come in from the east you may be turned away).

Rules

1. Ensure all participants have proper restraints to prevent potential injury due to sudden stops.
2. Skateboarders, roller blades, and bikers must wear helmets and protective gear and are NOT allowed to be towed by any float or vehicle. All entries must provide the driver proper visibility and control. Proper ventilation is a must!
3. Items such as candy, balloons, etc. may be given out to spectators by 'walkers' who accompany the entry and hand out treats from a safe distance by using small bags or pails. There is to be **no throwing of candy**, etc. from the floats for the sake of safety. **Violators will not be allowed to submit an entry the following year.**
4. No water guns or water balloon tossing.
5. All entries must be physically able to maintain the parade pace.
6. The ultimate responsibility for safety lies with each individual entry. Entries must comply with all rules and regulations, safety codes, manufacturer's recommendations and similar standards.
7. Parade official reserve the right to remove any entry, at any time, whether as a result of safety concerns, interference with parade's progress or any other reason officials deem necessary.
8. No smoking or alcoholic beverages are allowed on parade entries or by parade participants. Participants whom our parade Officials believe have consumed alcohol or prohibited drugs prior to or during the parade will be removed and not be accepted in future parades. Smoking will not be permitted on any float or horse entry on the parade route.
9. Along the parade route you may encounter traveling parade marshals who have the authority to ask you to slow down, speed up, etc.
10. Drivers of motorized vehicle must be at least 16 years of age. NO EXCEPTIONS.
11. **Limit of 2 large equipment pieces per company**
12. All oversize entries must have a person walking on each side to ensure crowd safety.
